

Congressman Brady will host dedication ceremonies to mark the renaming of three Philadelphia post offices in honor of city leaders (06/11/03)

PHILADELPHIA

--- Congressman Robert A. Brady (D., Pa.) will host dedication ceremonies to mark the renaming of area post offices in honor of three deceased city leaders. The name changes are the result of legislation introduced by Congressman Brady that was signed into law by President Bush, Oct. 30, 2002.

The Spring Garden Post Office, 1299 N. 7th St., will be renamed the Herbert Arlene Post Office Building, June 16 at 9:30 a.m.

The Southwark Post Office, 925 Dickinson St., will be renamed the William A. Cibotti Post Office Building, June 16 at 11 a.m.

The Logan Post Office, 6150 N. Broad St., will be renamed the Rev. Leon Sullivan Post Office, June 23 at 11 a.m.

The Congressman said, "The renaming of these postal facilities is an important tribute to the contributions these leaders made during their many years of service. They were legends in their communities and they deserve this honor."
