

## Congressman Brady to host dedication ceremony to mark the renaming of Logan post office in honor Rev. Leon Sullivan (06/18/03)

--- Congressman Robert A. Brady (D., Pa.) and U.S. Postal officials will host a dedication ceremony to mark the renaming of the Logan Post Office in honor of Rev. Leon Sullivan. "Rev. Sullivan is remembered throughout the world as a leader and a humanitarian. This designation represents the least I could do to honor a great man and a true servant of the people," the Congressman said.

Last year Congressman Brady introduced and secured passage of legislation designating the renaming of three post facilities in Philadelphia including the Logan Post Office, located at 6150 N. Broad St. President Bush signed the bills into law Oct.30, 2002.

Family, friends and members of the Zion Baptist Church will join Congressman Brady, David Fineman, Chairman, Postal Service Board Governors and Philadelphia Postmaster James Gallagher at the ceremony.
