

Central High School Senior's Work Selected For the Congressional High School Art Competition

PHILADELPHIA --- Congressman Robert A. Brady (D., PA) has selected the artwork of Anna Zhilkova, a senior at Central High School to represent the First Congressional District in the 26th annual Congressional High School Art Competition. The work, a black and white photo triptych composition featuring City Hall will be displayed with other winners from across the nation in a ten month exhibition in the U.S. Capitol.

Zhilkova's winning entry was a part of the School District of Philadelphia's "Art: It's Academic," annual spring exhibition. The nationwide art showcase, An Artistic Discovery, provides Members of Congress with the opportunity to showcase the talents of creative young artists in their districts.
